She continues to be active as a piano teacher, accompanist, and church organist/choir director.

Upon completing a Master of Music, Conducting degree, she moved to Vancouver Island where she directed the Cowichan Consort Orchestra and Choir, the Nanaimo Symphony, and the Victoria Civic Orchestra. She is currently a doctoral student in Choral Conducting at the University of Washington, where she conducts the Women’s Choir. Her dissertation focuses on Antonio Vivaldi’s choruses in the dramatic works.

Rykie Avenant, Encore! Women's Choir, graduated from the Conservatory of Music in Stellenbosch, South Africa, with both a Bachelor's Degree and a Performer's Licentiate in Music. She spent several years as an opera repetiteur in various international opera houses and also performed regularly at the Kathaumixw Festival before arriving in the Cowichan Valley.

Clint Gawthrop, Magnolia Chorale, is originally from Detroit, Michigan, and began piano studies at age eight. He soon added violin, trombone, and organ to his repertoire. He studied with Mischa Kottler, a prominent Detroit musician who had studied under Rachmaninoff. He moved to Seattle in 1994, and is a full time musician and piano teacher. 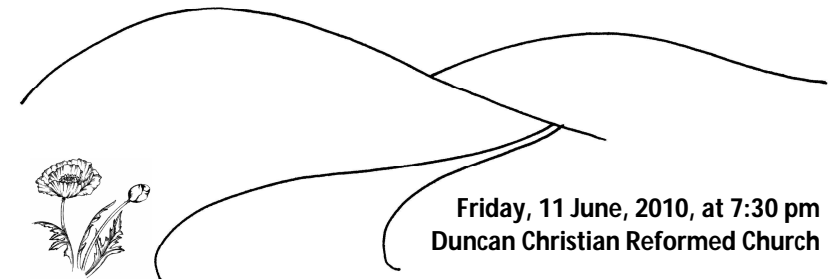
